

**Unborn Victims of Violence Act
Debate in U.S. House of Representatives
February 25-26, 2004**

Over the course of two days, February 25 and 26, 2004, the U.S. House of Representatives debated the Unborn Victims of Violence Act (H.R. 1997). The list below presents the 44 Members who spoke in favor of the bill and 27 who spoke in opposition. The days are noted on which Members made their statements. Representatives who spoke multiple times on a single day are noted with an asterisk.
